1. A great man and a heart of gold. A true Ohev Yisroel, dedicated to helping others in need. He was a dear and beloved friend of my dad obm. I recall as a young child, when my dad would shop in the East Side for clothing for us kids and seforim for the yeshiva library. He would deposit the boxes and bags of goods at Reb Leib's store in the East Side so that we wouldn't have to shlep them home on the numerous buses. Reb Leib would not only bring them into Brooklyn, but would hand deliver them to our home in East Flatbush and would not allow my father to lift the boxes.
